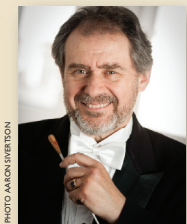

Our opening concert (at Crescent Fort Rouge), highlights the work of one of the greatest Romantic composers.

Peter Tchaikovsky is renowned for his symphonies, operas and ballets, and I'm pleased the Phil has the opportunity to introduce you to the remarkable beauty of both his and his contemporaries' choral music. I am certain that *Tchaikovsky and Beyond*—presented in conjunction with the WSO's Tchaikovsky Festival—will move and delight.

This work, often called the Russian Requiem, brings our season full circle, as it was composed by Sergey Taneyev—a student of Peter Tchaikovsky!

This season marks my thirteenth with the Phil, and I am proud to play a part in the Phil's great musical journey. I want to express my gratitude to our talented choristers, our hard-working volunteer board and our generous sponsors. But most of all, I thank *you*, our amazing audience. Your enthusiasm and love of choral excellence inspires us all. We look forward to sharing another thrilling season with you.
